CHAPTER 1:11-13

Ephesians 1:11-12

¹¹ In him we have obtained an <u>inheritance</u>, having been <u>predestined</u> according to the <u>purpose</u> of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, ¹² so that we who were the first to hope in <u>Christ</u> might be to the praise of his glory.

¹³ In him you <u>also</u>, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your <u>salvation</u>, and believed in him, were <u>sealed</u> with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the <u>guarantee</u> of our <u>inheritance</u> until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

- ¹¹ In him we have obtained an <u>inheritance</u>,
 The Greek word *eklerothemen*, "obtained an inheritance" means "chosen"
- ¹¹ ... Having been predestined To predetermine, Decide beforehand, God decreeing from eternity

11 ... according to the <u>purpose</u> of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will,

according to (divine) purpose, of the one energizing all things according to the counsel arising from His will.

This verse contains one of the strongest statements in Scripture that God is sovereign (cf. Ps. 115:3; Prov. 16:9, 33; Dan. 4:34-35). God is sovereign over "all things": "according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will." This includes the election of some people to salvation. - (Dr. Thomas Constable)

The Jews ("we") were first to put their trust ("hope") in Jesus Christ

Acts 3:25-26

Romans 1:16

Verse 6: "To the praise of his glorious grace."

Verse 12: "so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory."

Verse 14: "who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory."

13 In him you [the Gentiles] <u>also</u>, when you [the Gentiles] heard the word of truth, the gospel of your [the Gentiles] <u>salvation</u>, and believed in him, were <u>sealed</u> with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the <u>guarantee</u> of our [Jews and Gentiles] <u>inheritance</u> until we [Jews and Gentiles] acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Pre-destined

- 1 Peter 1:19-21 "Christ ... was foreknown before the foundation of the world..."
- **Ephesians 1:4** "...he chose us in him before the foundation of the world..."
- Hebrews 4:3 "...his works were finished from the foundation of the world."

1 Peter 2:8 "...They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do."
